### ENSURE IMMEDIATE SAFETY

Administer First Aid if able

### DETERMINE LOCATION

Confirm you are in BVI waters  
Use GPS or Local Island / Markers  
Have Boat name Ready

Call 999 First, then immediately call:

**BVI Marine Police: +1 (284) 368-3826**  
VHF Channel 16 - Request Medical Professional from Nearby Vessels
