### ENSURE IMMEDIATE SAFETY

Administer First Aid if able

### DETERMINE LOCATION

Confirm you are in USVI waters  
Use GPS or Local Island / Markers  
Have Boat name Ready

### CALL FOR HELP

Call 911 First, then immediately call:  
VI Rescue: +1-340-725-7377  
US Coast Guard: +1-787-289-2041  
IF USING YOUR BOAT'S VHF:  
Channel 16 - Radio: "MAYDAY - MAYDAY we are requesting Rescue assistance for a medical emergency"
